At the market in Japan, the most conspicuous change was the decline of yen. It really plunged 24 per cent against US dollar during a year, but in spite of such a big yen's depreciation, Japanese consumer price did not almost change. It was very lucky and very happy for civil life.

At our metals market, most prices went up 10 per cent odd without regard for the dwindled international market prices in US dollar.

It stands out that the fuel oil rose and the gold weakened.
