Estimated aluminum demand in fiscal 2015 increases 1.8%

The Aluminum Survey Group made up of seven bodies (Light Metal Manufacturers Association, Japan Aluminum Alloy Refiners Association, Japan Sash Association, Japan Aluminum Association, Japan Electric Wire Association, Japan Diecast Association and Aluminum Can Recycling Association) recently revealed the presumption of total aluminum demand in fiscal 2014 started in April 2014 and ended in March 2015, and its forecast in fiscal 2015 started in April 2015 and ends in March 2016.

According to the announcement, the presumed demand in fiscal 2014 reached 4,086,000ton, which was the first 4 million ton level in past seven years. But it couldn't attain the highest record, 4,457,000ton, marked in 2006.

In fiscal 2014, the export was active, and specially, both the sheet for coffee can and the export of knock-down auto parts stood out.

Regarding the prediction of total demand in fiscal 2015, it increases 1.8 per cent from the previous fiscal year to 4,161,000. It is thought that the domestic automobile production remains lower level, however as same as in the previous fiscal year, the sheet production for coffee can and the export of knock-down auto parts are expected to keep favorable level.

Power consumption dwindles in fiscal 2014

The Electric Power Federation recently revealed the preliminary total electric power consumption in fiscal 2014 started in April 2014 and ended in March 2015. According to the report, the total power consumption in fiscal 2014 decreased 3.0 per cent to 823 billion KWH, which decreased for past four years successively.

Among major seven types of business, nonferrous metals industry, only one, rose 2.1 per cent year on year and other six types of business declined, the federation disclosed.

Furthermore, the federation announced the power consumption in March only, which decreased 3.8 per cent from the previous period to 70.3 billion KWH, and these figures make us prudent.

<u>Lackluster crude steel production in fiscal 2014</u>

On 20 April, the Japan Steel Federation revealed the total crude steel production in fiscal 2014, which decreased 1.5 per cent from a year earlier to 109 billion ton.

At the same time, the federation announced that the production in March only dwindled 4.5 per cent from a year earlier to 9.286 million ton. This showed successive seven months decline.

With the electric power consumption as shown above, Japanese key industries' future is concerned.
